2019 Watering Guidelines

Irrigation season is here!

Since water is a limited resource in our dry climate, using water wisely can save you money. *AND*, it's the right thing to do!

Parker Water asks you to do your part and water efficiently this summer.

⇒ Voluntary alternating watering days based on address:

Homes ending in an EVEN number = SUNDAY, TUESDAY, THURSDAY
Homes ending in an ODD number = MONDAY, WEDNESDAY, SATURDAY
Multifamily, HOA's, Commercial properties = MONDAY, WEDNESDAY, SATURDAY

No watering on Fridays so water storage tanks can refill for the weekend.

- ⇒ **No irrigation between 10 a.m. & 6 p.m.** Water will evaporate & not benefit your landscape!
- ⇒ *Water waste is prohibited* Watch for runoff, over spray, and leaks.

Efficient Irrigation Tips

For Lawns - Based on 3 days per Week				
Minutes To Water Per Zone				
Months	Spray Heads	Rotor Heads	Rotary Nozzles	Manual Sprinklers
May	12	21	30	18
June	17	35	43	26
July	18	36	45	27
Aug	14	27	34	20
Sept	11	23	28	17
Oct-Dec	Water trees & shrubs as needed through winter			

Recommendations are weather/plant material/irrigation efficiency dependent.

Watch for runoff & adjust your times.

Adjust Your Timer – <u>Don't set it & forget it!</u>
Update your irrigation timer monthly to adjust for seasonal plant needs.

Know When to Turn Your System Off -

- ⇒ Don't irrigate while it's raining or windy.
- ⇒ Don't water between 10 a.m. -6 p.m.

Cycle & Soak – Apply water in multiple short cycles to avoid runoff, promote deeper roots & a healthier lawn. Wait 30 minutes to 1 hour in between cycles.
